Program Rationale

- A program that is committed to inclusive services that provide a climate of mutual respect and understanding.
- The program has potential for sustainability by strengthening existing community networks.
- The provision for early intervention impacts the health and well-being in later life.

Aim

- The PCMGP is a group experience for parents and their babies and young children which focuses on the pleasure and power of using rhymes, songs, and stories together. Parents gain skills and confidence which can enable them to create positive family patterns during their children's crucial early years, and give their children healthy early experiences with language and communication.

Objectives

- Early years services have an increased role in fostering linkages between family capacity and community connectedness.
- PCMG Facilitators support families in activities which aim to increase their knowledge, skills and abilities.
- Improved collaboration between PCMG Facilitators, families and existing community services
- Strong linkages exist between early years services and broader community services to raise the importance of the early years.
